


<u>Newtodenmark.dk</u> is a web portal available in Danish and English, which provides comprehensive information on entry and residence formalities in Denmark in a user friendly format. <u>Newtodenmark.dk</u> is maintained jointly by the Danish Immigration Service and the Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration. The primary target group of the portal are foreign nationals who wish to reside in Denmark, or are already residing here, as well as their family members. The portal is helpfully divided into the following 5 sections:

- You want to apply to visit, live or work in Denmark
- You have applied and are waiting for an answer to your application
- You have received an answer to your application
- You want to extend your stay
- Your situation is changing



Each section is then subdivided in several subcategories. Special categories for EU citizens and their family members explain the rules applicable to them pursuant to EU law and provide links to the relevant websites of Danish national authorities. It is particularly notable that:

- a specific section ("<u>Apply for visa under EU Regulations</u>") provides information about the special entry rules and procedure which applies to non-EU family members of EU nationals, separate from entry rules for other TCNs.
- a specific section ("<u>Family Reunification with Danish national under EU law</u>"), explains the special EU rules which apply the non-EU family members of Danish nationals who have exercised their free movement rights by living in another EU country.
- the section on "Family reunification with Union citizens or EEA nationals in Denmark" explains in details the EU rules, including concepts defined in EU law such as what is "genuine and effective residence", how "sufficient resources" can be proven and how the Danish authorities can re-examine family reunification cases following various judgments of the Court of Justice of the EU.
- Extensive information on appeal rights is provided in the section "<u>You have received</u> <u>an answer to your application</u>"
- The status of one's visa or residence card application can be viewed via the "<u>My</u> <u>Page</u>" part of the portal by those that have a NemID (a common secure log-in solution available to all those who have a national identification number (CPR) in Denmark.

For submitting applications within Denmark, appointments can be booked <u>online</u>.
