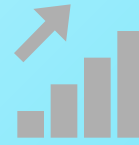

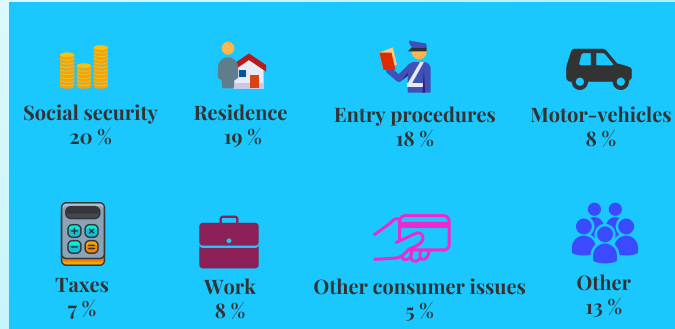
These enquiries provide an insight into the problems experienced by EU citizens and businesses regarding their personal EU rights, including freedom of movement

Topics of the enquiries received (%)

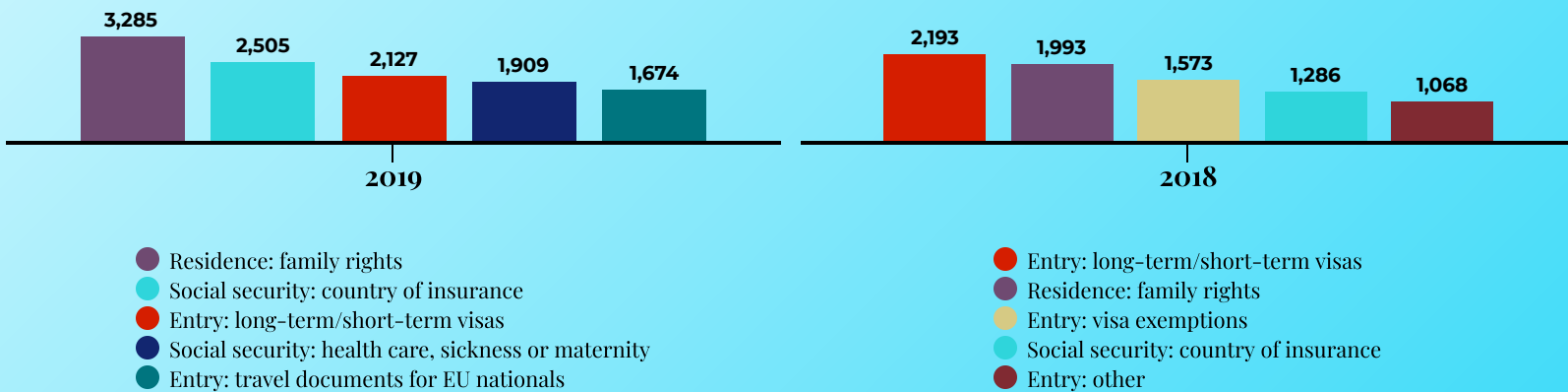


Topics in the "other" category include:
